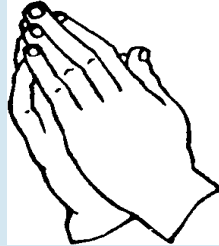

Baby Bottle Campaign 2021...Jackson Knights of Columbus collected \$4,901.92 in this effort; \$2,450.96 each will go to Birthright of Cape Girardeau (and Marble Hill) and to Options for Women in Cape Girardeau. Since 2012, when the MO State K of C Ultra Sound Initiative began, the Jackson council has collected and distributed \$30,710.71 to Options for Women of Cape and \$16,935.91 to Birthright of Cape (and Marble Hill). Of that, 83% (\$39,709.12) was collected in the eight Baby Bottle Campaigns since 2013 at IC Parish. Thank you for your faithful participation!

In an effort to make your consistent giving easier, faster and more secure we are transitioning to a new online giving platform called Pushpay. It is our goal to complete this process soon. Part One: Setting up a new recurring gift using Pushpay. Visit <https://pushpay.com/pay/g/icjacksonmo> and set up your automatic gift using Pushpay. The recurring gift option should already be selected, and you can simply set up your automatic gift. After you set up your recurring gift, you will be prompted to complete the setup of your new account!

Part Two: Cancel scheduled gifts in WeShare. Log into your account; click the "payments & schedules" tab; delete each payment, or if you would like us to cancel your recurring gift on our old platform please call Kelly at the parish office.

VIRTUS 2021-2022 Safe Environment Instruction - In-person "Protecting God's Children" adult awareness training sessions are now available. New registrants are encouraged to take the in-person training, but the online training will remain available as an alternative for the remainder of 2021.

Pre-registration is necessary: If you are a new registrant please go to www.virtus.org and click on "first time registrant" on the left, and follow the prompts to register for Live or Online training.
