## Options for Women

Thank you so much for your generous donation in July of \$1,318.50, and to all who contributed to the Baby Bottle Campaign totaling \$3,381.58. Your kindness and commitment to protecting and supporting life make a real difference for the mothers, fathers, and babies we serve. Since mid-2014, we have worked with 147 abortion-vulnerable or abortion-minded mothers who chose life for their unborn babies following consultation, pregnancy testing, and ultrasound services.

During our most recent fiscal year:

- We hosted more than 1,600 client visits to the center.
- We held 359 Parenting Class sessions.
- We distributed over 1,155 "Bags of Blessings" (food) to our clients and 158 food boxes to the community.
- We provided 32 New Baby Baskets of supplies to moms of newborns.
- We supplied 63,804 diapers and 1,792 packages of wipes to class participants and community families in need.
