### NEW CHURCH PROJECT

All steel and metal trusses are complete. The metal decking for the roof is now being installed. This will be followed by a layer of sheathing consisting of foam insulation and wood sheets to which the asphalt shingles will be attached. Please continue to pray for a mild winter that will be favorable for construction.

Volunteers have completed the painting and flooring required for the temporary office location at Unit 220B East Monroe St., next to the bowling alley, where the TV Repair shop once operated. Also, volunteers are currently taking apart and re-constructing the wood shelving in the basement storage area in preparation for our office move, now scheduled for early April. We will be calling on other volunteers as we get closer to moving time.

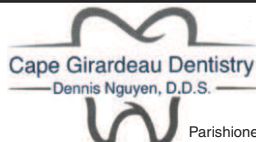

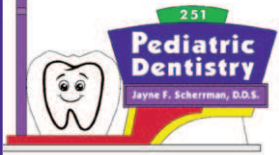
