Exterior wall sheathing has been installed on three sides of the building. The west end (front of the church) will be framed out in the near future. The Connector to the rectory and covered drop off have been framed up. The Final Capital Campaign Phase continues. We are currently looking at a potential debt of \$2.5 million, so continued fund raising to reduce the debt is critical in order to reduce interest costs that will be incurred over the next several years.
