Progress on the New Church

The Connector to the rectory has been framed up and roof decking completed. The sprinkler system piping is installed. A 10-inch-thick layer of foam insulation has been sprayed onto the bottom of the roof deck, in addition to the insulated sheathing sections installed on top of the roof deck. The main water line coming into the building from old Jefferson Street was completed. The exterior stairs have been poured. Brick work will hopefully start in the next couple of weeks. We are currently looking at a potential debt of \$2.5 million, so continued fund raising to reduce the debt is critical in order to reduce interest costs that will be incurred over the next several years.

We will move all the offices and will be operational in the new offices on Monday, March 30th. Our current offices will be closed permanently at that point. Please be patient with us as we work our way through this transition of offices and various ministries.
