## NEW CHURCH PROJECT – A BIG THANK YOU

to all our volunteers who have helped with our big moves. We completed the final moves out of the church basement and moved Father into his new temporary residence at 2225 Bainbridge. The Fellowship Room is permanently closed at this point, as is the rectory. Our new offices are fully operational at 220 E. Monroe St., Ste. B now. Asbestos removal in the rectory began on Monday and will continue through the next several weeks. Our last Mass and de-consecration of the Church by Bishop Rice is still scheduled for May 17th. Masses will begin on May 18th in the Parish Center. To help with debt payment over the next several years we continue to look for new pledges, payments, and/or estate gifting. We are currently looking at a potential debt of \$2.5 million, so continued fund raising to reduce the debt is critical in order to reduce interest costs that will be incurred over the next several years.
