New Church Project - A Huge Thank You

to all the volunteers who showed up to salvage, move, and re-set the church in the Parish Center. Approximately 60 volunteers showed up and worked together like clockwork. Everything was removed and reset in less than half a day. By the end of the day, the new temporary church area was fine-tuned, cleaned, and ready for Mass and Adoration on Tuesday. Jesus is now present at all times in the tabernacle in the Parish Center. All of the west side and large front stained-glass windows were removed before workers left Tuesday evening. Asbestos abatement in the church has begun. Demolition is scheduled to begin on June 1st. As can be seen, the roof on the new church is on and brick laying has started on the north side. The Columbia Construction on site office has been moved into the church basement. Rectory construction is scheduled to begin in early June—Volunteers are very much needed. 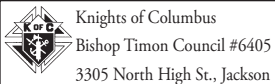

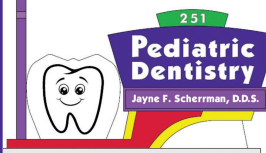
