### **NEW CHURCH PROJECT**

Footing was poured for the south wall of the church the week before last. This past week work began on forming the south foundation wall. Wet soil is also now being excavated and stored on site for future backfill. Rock is being hauled in and compacted for the basement floor. Over the course of the summer, we expect to see all the footings and foundation walls completed, the basement floor poured and structural steel starting to go up in August.

### Office of Child & Youth Protection

### **Reporting Procedures of Known or Suspected Abuse and** Misconduct

- Any known or suspected abuse or neglect of a minor must first be immediately reported to the Missouri Child Abuse and Neglect Hotline at 800-392-3738.
- Any known or suspected abuse or neglect of an adult must first be immediately reported to the Missouri Adult Abuse and Neglect Hotline at 800-392-0210.
- In situations of immediate danger, call 911.

Known or suspected abuse may also be reported to law enforcement in addition to making a report to the MO Child Abuse and Neglect Hotline or to the MO Adult Abuse and Neglect Hotline.

Concerns and violations of The Code of Conduct should also be reported to the Office of Child and Youth Protection at 417-866-0841 or by email at **childandyouthprotection@dioscg.org** or through the TIPS online reporting system available on the diocesan website www.dioscg.org.

Violations involving the Bishop should also be reported to the Catholic Bishop Abuse Reporting Service at 800-276-1562 or https://reportbishopabuse.org/.

The Safe Environment Policy and Procedures, the Code of Conduct for Clergy, Employees and Adult Volunteers and other important information, including a link to the USCCB Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People are available on the webpage <a href="https://dioscg.org/child-youth-protection/">https://dioscg.org/child-youth-protection/</a>.

### Safe Environment Requirements for all diocesan personnel clergy, employees and adult volunteers

The mission and ministry of creating a safe environment for all to flourish and thrive is a responsibility we all share.

Before regularly working or volunteering with minors or vulnerable adults, all diocesan personnel (clergy, employees and adult volunteers) are required to first complete:

- the Safe Environment Training;
- a Background Screening; and,
- a current, signed Code of Conduct.

The Safe Environment training is available online after creating an account in the VIRTUS system (through the VIRTUS webpage https://www.virtusonline.org/virtus/).

he Code of Conduct is required annually and is made available at the beginning of the fiscal year, July 1, and expires December 31 the following year.

The Background Screening Application is now accessed through the VIRTUS account.




