New Rectory Construction

New Church Project - Parking & Vehicle Circulation

Demolition and site work will necessitate closing the Jefferson St. entrance to the school parking lot this week for the duration of the summer. A new entrance will be constructed and ready to open before school starts in August. In the meantime, entry to and exit from the parking lot will be solely through the south gate. Madison St. will be changed back to 2-way for the summer. After entry into the parking lot vehicles should proceed straight ahead and then circle to the left to get back to exit.

Salvage operations were completed with removal of the exterior Mary statue, which will be reused on the wall of the new church or rectory. Stained glass window removal was successful along with removal of the circular baldacchino from over the altar area. We plan to reuse at least some of the stained glass in the basement fellowship room of the new church. Brick is continuing around the Apse area. Painting of the interior Apse and installation of trim in the Apse was completed this past week. Refurbishment of the Stations of the Cross and Stained Glass Windows continues. Construction of the main entry is nearing completion. Steeple installation, construction of ceiling in the Nave, and refurbishment of the high altar, will all be started during this month of June, along with construction of the rectory.

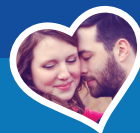

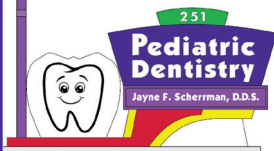
