NEW CHURCH PROJECT- CONSTRUCTION UPDATE:

installation is nearly complete. The ceiling areas of the nave, choir loft, and apse have been completed. Other painting work will continue for the next several weeks. Brick on the main entrance and bell tower will continue over the next few weeks. Trim pieces are currently being installed as well.
