New Church Project:

The church basement floor was poured this past week. The walls of the connecting building between the church and the rectory are ready to be poured. The columns at the front entrance of the church are being formed up to be ready to pour in the next couple of weeks. Steel has arrived to build the bell tower and install the main floor joists. We received a marble statue of Mary (6'7" tall) which has been donated by Blessed Art, a company that sells Holy Land Art each year in our diocese. They are also arranging for a marble Joseph statue to be provided at a very low cost. Our existing Mary and Joseph statues in church will be salvaged and re-used in the Adoration Chapel when it is built. An updated project timeline is now posted with the large renderings in the vestibule of the church. Completion is still expected in November of next year.




