



Principal's Report (Ms. Campbell):

- 2025-2026 school year current enrollment: 36 students in Pre-K, 142 students in K-8.
- Teacher letters of intent went out as well as letters of intent to return for student families.
- Ms. Dennis has submitted her letter of retirement.
- Honor roll recognition certificates will be presented to students who made the honor roll.

Committee Reports:

- **Athletic Committee (Ms. Graves)** – Two boys' volleyball teams this spring. Ten 7th and 8th graders will participate for Track and Field with the St. Sebastian Arrows. The gym needs a new scorer's table.
- **Christian Service (Ms. Campbell)** – Both 7th and 8th grade classes are doing well with obtaining their required service hours.
- **Marketing Committee (Ms. Guyot)** – Continuing to do monthly bulletin inserts highlighting different aspects of our school. Procuring digital billboard for Catholic Schools Week, Spring Fling, and MO Scholars. Developing game day graphics for sports teams and assisted with 8th grade student athlete posters to hang in the gym.
- **Parish Council (Ms. Gibbs)** – No Parish Council meeting in December. Discussing February parish get together.
- **Home and School (Ms. Holzum)** – Jimmy John's restaurant night was successful as was the Craft Fair. Christmas Parade float won Mayor's Choice Award. Cookies with Santa was well attended. KC Fish Fry for restaurant night is January 16th. Pancake and Sausage breakfast will be January 25th. Trivia night is January 30th. Spring Fling raffles are ongoing. Almost all families have signed up to work Spring Fling.

Old Business:

- MO Scholars opened enrollment for the 26-27 school year for new families and current MO Scholars student's siblings. Several new families have signed up for MO Scholars indicating they would attend IC.
