

Do you pay MO state income taxes?



Missouri allows you to re-direct half of the taxes you are required to pay towards Catholic education.

The Bright Futures Fund provides Catholic school scholarships to qualified students funded with purchased tax credits. When you file your taxes, you get 100% credit for the amount you reserved and paid. Help us fund over \$12 million in scholarships by reserving tax credits for up to half of your annual liability. Redirecting taxes to empower students with a Catholic education is another opportunity for good stewardship. It just makes sense!

HOW TO RESERVE TAX CREDITS IN 5 EASY STEPS

Step 1

GO TO **BRIGHT FUTURES FUND.ORG**

Click on "MOScholars Program-Reserve MOScholars Tax Credits".

Step 2

ESTIMATE YOUR LIABILITY **BASED ON WHAT YOU** OWED THE PREVIOUS YEAR

Fill out all fields for the MOScholars Tax Credit Reservation System. You can reserve tax credits for up to half of what you will owe.

Step 3

CHOOSE BRIGHT **FUTURES FUND**

Select

Bright Futures Fund from the EAO (Educational Assistance Organization) drop down menu.

Step 4

RESERVE YOUR TAX **CREDIT AMOUNT BEFORE DECEMBER 31**

Click "submit" and you will receive an email from the MO State Treasurer's office. Print and save your

confirmation number.

Step 5 WRITE A CHECK TO THE BRIGHT FUTURES FUND

Write a check to the Bright Futures Fund for the amount of the tax credits reserved. Mail the check within 30 days of your reservation and no later than December 31 to: Bright Futures Fund, P.O. Box 419037, Kansas City, MO, 64141. After your funds are received and verified, you will receive an email receipt from the State Treasurer's Office. Include the receipt and an MO-TC form with your state income tax filing.

- 100% of an eligible contribution and can be used for up to 50% of the donor's annual tax liability.

HOW TO APPLY FOR A MOSCHOLARS SCHOLARSHIP

Go to **BrightFuturesFund.org**. Click on **MOScholars Program** then MOScholars **Scholarships**. Click the button for your diocese. Fill out the pre-qualification form to see if you qualify to move on to the formal application.

Qualifying Paths

To qualify, your student must meet one or more of the state designated criteria. Scholarships are verified by F. A.C.T. S, granted in order according to state rules based on available funding.

- Siblings of current MOScholars recipients
- Students with an approved IEP 'individualized education plan' developed under federal Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) or an individual service plan (ISP) that is developed in cooperation with a local education agency under IDEA, specifically those provisions pertaining to parentally placed private school children found in 20 U.S. Code 1412 (a) (10) and 34 CFR 300(b).*
- Attended a public school as a full time student for at least one semester during the previous twelve (12) months.
- ▶ Are eligible to begin kindergarten or first grade
- Must meet MOScholars income eligibility guidelines

*Any IEP or ISP that is proffered for program eligibility must be dated within the last I2 months of the date of the student's application to the program.

Students with ISPs that are not developed under IDEA are not eligible.


