The council tabled a decision for next year's President Elect until next meeting, due to the absence of several members.

Father Randy reported on the progress of the new church, highlighting recent concrete and steel work. The organ installers stored all of the pieces in Union, MO under climate-controlled conditions, where it will remain until the new church building is completely dust free and ready. Bishop Rice will deconsecrate the current church building on May 17<sup>th</sup>. Rental office space for the upcoming year has been located, but a place for Father Randy to live is still needed. The parish will celebrate our upcoming December 8<sup>th</sup> feast day with mass, then a procession around the parking lot, and a reception hosted by St. Ann's.

Father Randy reported on Youth Group doing quite well with activities every Sunday and trip opportunities upcoming this summer.

Next month, parish council members will pray the Christmas Novena together on December 17<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 in the church. The next parish council meeting will occur on January 21<sup>st</sup>.
