

**Principal's Report (Ms. Campbell):**

- 2025-2026 school year current enrollment: 36 students in Pre-K, 142 students in K-8.
- Preschool classes are full for next year. Discussed space needs for additional classrooms and some church offices.
- Mrs. Dennis is retiring. Mrs. Burford is not returning. All other teachers expressed they plan to return.
- Heard from all pre-school families via letters of intent. Still reviewing K-8 letters of intent.
- Teacher jobs will be posted soon.

**Committee Reports:**

- **Athletic Committee (Ms. Graves)** –Mr. Bova raised some funds for a new score table, but needs more. Boys volleyball practice starts this week. IC will have boys volleyball A and B/C teams. Ten students are participating in track with St. Sebastian Arrows.
- **Christian Service (Ms. Campbell)** – No report.
- **Marketing Committee (Ms. Guyot)** –January's bulletin insert focused on Kindergarten. A DSW billboard will hi-light different IC events. Working on ads for Spring Fling and boys volleyball graphics.
- **Parish Council (Ms. Gibbs)** – Will host parish soup social on February 15<sup>th</sup>. No meeting in February due to Ash Wednesday.
- **Home and School (Ms. Holzum)** – KC Fish Fry restaurant night raised \$2,165. Trivia Night and Pancake Breakfast both went well. Focusing on Spring Fling by encouraging all families/parishioners to attend. Also working on a Spring Fling invite with logistics and what to expect for the evening.
