April Parish Council Meeting Minutes

President Tom Krydyski called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday, April 15th, 2026, with eight members and Fr. Randy present. Fr. Randy opened the meeting in prayer.

Fr. Randy reported that workers have started the process of asbestos removal from the rectory. Father has moved into his temporary accommodation. Plumbing is being roughed in the new church, as well as the duct work, roof, and steel walls. Still checking on the brick for the new church. Lighting and sound for the new church will be installed in May. Last mass at our current building will be May 17th, then it will be in the parish center afterward until the new church is finished. The old church will be demolished starting June 1st. Thirteen people joined our parish at Easter. The church will have 33 children at First Communion next Sunday.

Barbie Gibbs reported on the minutes from last IC School Board meeting. The gym roof is still leaking. The school spring fling dinner auction raised over \$150,000 for the school. The recently held Don Carlos fundraiser night was a success for the school. Teachers have been hired for the next school year, and summer care has been taken care of. There is an expectation of 187-190 students for the next school year.

Fr. Randy reported that the 2026 Diocesan Eucharistic Congress in West Plains, MO is on August 15th. The Diocese currently has 1,200 people signed up from throughout the Diocese. IC currently has 10 people signed up to travel on the church bus, which will be leaving at 6am.

Father Randy reported Karen Engelen will attend Life Teen and Steubenville with the Youth Group this summer, but the position will need to be filled by a new youth minister as she will begin her role as principal this fall.

The Parish Picnic will be on August 23rd at the Jackson KC Hall from 12-3pm. The purpose of this event is to promote community within our parish. Food plans, tables/chairs, musical entertainment, games, and activities for children were discussed. Council members will be responsible for set up and clean up.

Fr. Randy discussed the need for nominations for Parish Council for this upcoming year. Tom Krydyski, Darline Bullinger, and Anna Bergmark have finished their three-year term. There will be no May, June or July parish council meetings. After the summer, regular meetings resume starting Wednesday August 19th, before the parish picnic.

Tom Krydyski closed the meeting in prayer.
