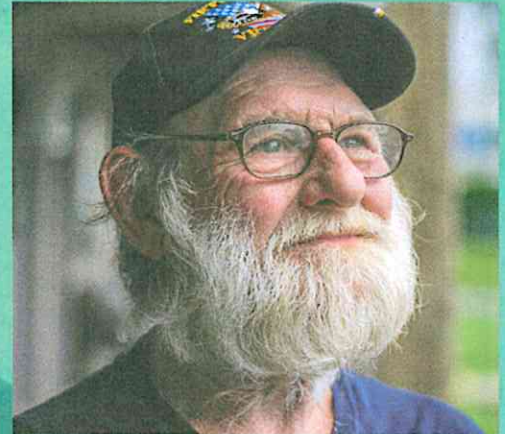


CHANGING LIVES

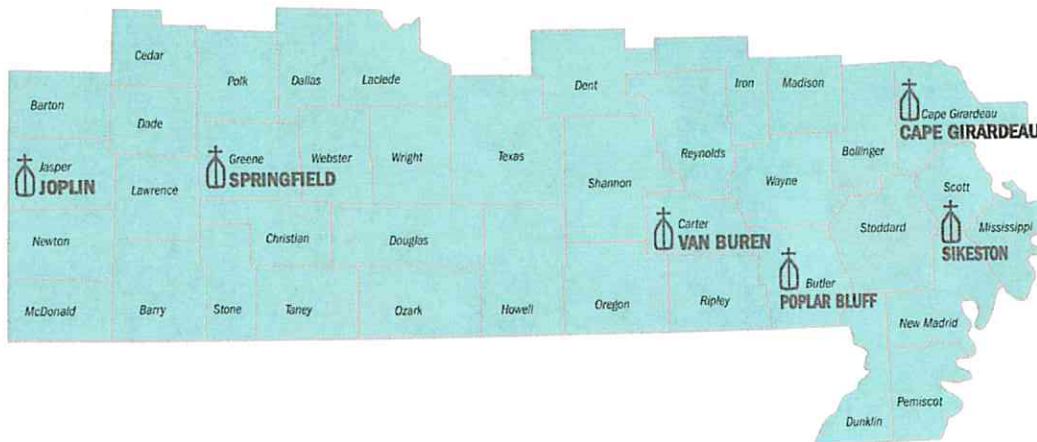
